

# **The Home Guard Community Charcoal BBQ Rules**

## ***General Usage***

### **Booking:**

The BBQ is available on a first-come, first-serve basis free for members during regular opening hours. BBQ can be booked in advance for use at a private hire at the cost of £25 per booking. Bookings can be made through The Home Guard's official website or contacting the bar manager or staff on site.

### **Members Only:**

The BBQ is for the exclusive use of The Home Guard members and their guests. Members must be present with guests at all times. Members are required to check the BBQ out at the bar and leave their name and contact details including member number with the bar staff.

### **Age Restriction:**

Operators of the BBQ must be at least 18 years of age.

### **Hours of Operation:**

The BBQ is available for use during club opening hours up until 10 PM. All cooking must be completed and cleared up by 10 PM. Respect the quiet hours.

## ***Safety and Cleanliness***

### **Fire Safety:**

Always have a fire extinguisher or a source of water nearby when the BBQ is in use. There is a tap outside next to the marquee for this purpose.

### **Supervision:**

Never leave the BBQ unattended when it's lit.

### **Food Safety:**

Handle food safely to avoid contamination.

### **Clean Up:**

Clean the BBQ grill, utensils, and surrounding area thoroughly after use. If the grill is too hot to clean properly, please arrange to come back the following day to finish the cleaning.

### **Waste Management:**

Dispose of waste in the designated bins and recycling areas.

## ***Usage Guidelines***

### **Fuel:**

Only use charcoal or kiln dried wood as fuel. The use of other materials is strictly prohibited.

### **Temperature Control:**

Monitor and control the temperature to avoid overcooking and flare-ups.

### **Utensils and Equipment:**

Use provided utensils and equipment properly. Report any damages or issues.

**Noise Control:**

Keep noise to a minimum to respect other members and neighbours.

**Smoke Management:**

Ensure the smoke does not disturb other members or neighbours.

***Etiquette***

**Respect Time Limits:**

If others are waiting, please limit BBQ use to 2 hours. If a member is handing the BBQ over to another member, remember to inform the bar staff otherwise you may be held responsible for cleaning and/or damages.

**Personal Items:**

Keep personal items clear of the BBQ and seating areas when not in use.

**Courtesy:**

Be courteous and respectful to other members and staff at all times.

***Consequences***

**Violation Consequences:**

Violating these rules may result in suspension of BBQ privileges.

**Liability:**

Members are liable for any damages caused to the BBQ or surrounding property.

**Incident Reporting:**

Report any incidents, damages, or issues to The Home Guard bar staff immediately.
